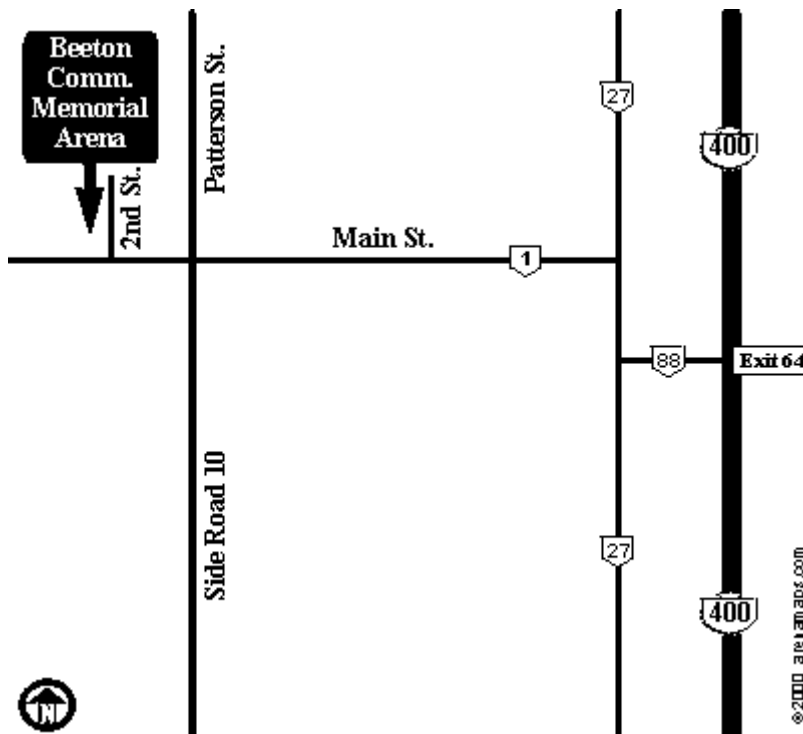

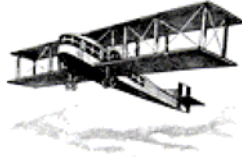

Haugen's B-B-Q is located about 25 minutes North of Highway 401 on Highway 12 at Hwy 7A. If coming from the 401 east, take Brock Street (Whitby) exit and head North. Note that Brock Street becomes Highway 12, then becomes Highway 7 as it goes north of the town of Brooklyn. Haugen's will be on the right side just before the Highway 7A turn into Port Perry. (IMPORTANT) If coming from the West on the 401, make sure you use the Brock Street exit, not the Brock Road exit near Pickering! A nominal \$10 fee at the gate buys you a full day of great fun and camaraderie. See you there! 3
